



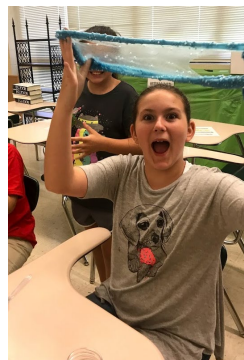
# St. George Summer Camp Registration 2019
