Room Parent:

Room Parents will assist teachers in recruiting volunteers and aid in planning and organizing class activities. Room Parents receive a Class Activity List from teachers to secure volunteers for class events. They coordinate and oversee these activities all year to ensure that they are carried out in the best manner possible. Room Parents will be notified of their class assignments via email. Each class will have 2 Room Parents, and they will share responsibilities.

Reception Committee (Pre-K - 8):

This committee is responsible for the reception portion of Grandparent's Day (November), Neighbor's Way Reception (February), and First Eucharist Reception (May). Duties include helping organize the event, decorating the reception area, and serving refreshments. This is a great way to meet people!

Baker's Committee (Pre-K - 8):

Send baked items throughout the year for events such as Grandparent's Day, Teacher Appreciation Week, Para Liturgy Reception, First Eucharist, etc. *Store bought good are welcome!*

Vision and Hearing Screenings (Pre-K - 8):

Screenings are held in the fall and are coordinated by the school nurse. A chairperson will contact you directly regarding the schedule (2 hour shifts); no experience is necessary. Trained professionals will be on site to assist with the screenings.

Office Copy Corps (Pre-K - 8):

Copy Corps volunteers duplicate tests and handouts for teachers. Volunteers work a 9:00-11:00am shift Monday through Thursday. The copying schedule is: Monday, 3rd, 4th & 8th; Tuesday, 5th & 7th; Wednesday, K, 2nd & 6th; and Thursday, 1st, 4th & 5th. Parents may ONLY volunteer on days when papers are not being copied for their child's grade. (Example: If you have a 2nd grade child, you cannot volunteer on Wednesdays.) Pre-K copy corp will be contacted as needed. Volunteers will be trained on an individual basis.

Carpool Volunteer (Pre-K - 8):

Volunteers are needed to assist with carpool the first week and a half of school.

Performing and Creative Arts (Pre-K - 8):

This is a committee of parent volunteers working to support the Performing and Creative Arts at St. George School. No monthly meetings are required! You will simply be called upon by the Performing & Creative Arts teachers on an as needed basis to help with Grandparent's Day, Art Show, Talent, Show, Bulletin Board, etc.

St. George Fair and Auction Committee (Pre-K - 8):

The fair and auction need your help too! If you are willing to be on the Fair Steering Committee, chair a booth at the fair, or lend your ideas to the auction committee, please let us know.

Field Day Event Committee (Pre-K) :

Used Uniform Sale (Pre-K - 8):

At the end of each school year as well as the Back to School Bash, the Home & School Association sponsors a used uniform sale. Volunteers are needed to assist with this event one Friday afternoon/evening and/or Saturday morning in the summer.

Library Committee (K - 8):

This committee will assist in helping the library staff and library chair in various duties throughout the year. These may include helping set-up the book fair, shelve books, as well as monthly AR incentives.

Cafeteria Angels (Pre-K - 8):

Cafeteria Angels assist in the serving line. Volunteers are needed every day of the week and can specify which day and week of the month they would prefer to assist.

Lost and Found Committee (K - 8):

Volunteers will meet periodically throughout the year to organize items in the Lost and Found.

Box Tops Committee (Pre-K - 8):

Volunteers will meet four times throughout the year (during a weekday) to count and clip labels from the fundraising programs at St. George.
